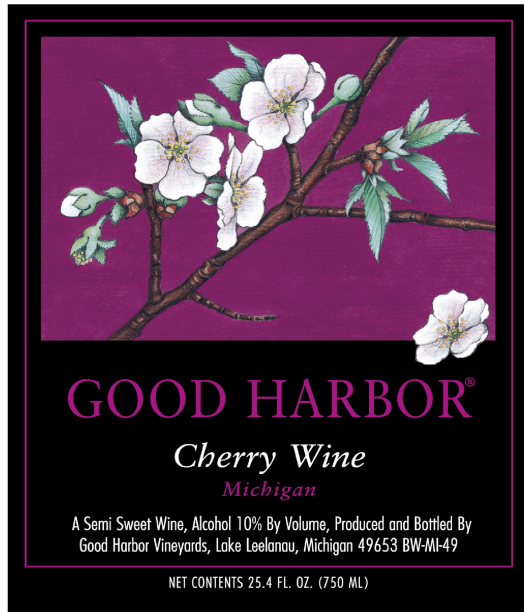


# Good Harbor Vineyards
